

STEM VIDEO COMPETITION

JUDGING CRITERIA

Judges will consider the following criteria when reviewing your entry:

- Clear message about the relationship between STEM and you (6 points)
- Ability to deliver STEM concept (3 points)
- Use of technology available to the entrant(s) (3 points)
- Creativity (3 points)
- Use of reliable references (3 points)
- Video quality (3 points)
- Originality (3 points)
- Adherence to entry rules (up to 2 penalty points)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON JUDGING

- Sample questions to get you thinking:
 - How does STEM - science, technology, engineering and math affect your daily activities? (transportation, how you communicate with people, do homework, where you get your food, how you control your environment - temperature, sound,...)
 - How does STEM (for example, the rivers, tech advances or engineering) affect your health?
 - How does STEM (i.e. the weather, computers/Internet...) affect what you can do (for example, sports, a career, education)?
- Ability to deliver STEM concept
After viewing your film, is the audience able to articulate your STEM concept? How well? Do your artistic style, your sounds, your imagery, your captions, and other elements best support getting the knowledge to your viewers?
- Use of technology available to the entrant
Camera, tripod, lighting, microphone - how did you use them? How well?
- Creativity, use of original approach or concept
Does the film take an unusual approach? Is it refreshing? Do you use a unique voice? Do you have a signature style?
- Research involved
A good bibliography should be included, as appropriate. Is it good science? Give appropriate credit. Does it show an aspect of your working knowledge?
